HOT TOPICS IN RENAL TRANSPLANTATION:

The late post-transplant phase

COURSE AIM

This meeting traditionally brings together investigators and clinicians with foremost experience in kidney transplantation, to discuss topics related to kidney transplant care. The different fields of expertise of the invited speakers, and the friendly relationships among the participants make this a unique opportunity for discussing advances in kidney transplantation in an informal setting. Failure of a kidney transplant is still a major problem after kidney transplantation, in spite of optimization of immunosuppressive protocols and clinical management to improve long-term graft survival. The theme of this year is new molecular diagnostic tools in kidney transplant rejection and their application in clinical practice. In addition, recurrent glomerular diseases in the graft will be also discussed.
