



Young Professionals in Transplantation (YPT) Workshop
12th International Living Donor Abdominal Organ Transplant Conference
9-11 May 2026, Murano, Italy

On Saturday 9 May 2026, there will be a unique opportunity to participate in the **Young Professionals in Transplantation (YPT) Workshop** on living organ donation and the subsequent **12th International Living Donor Abdominal Organ Transplant Conference**, to be held on Sunday and Monday 10-11 May 2026 in Murano, Italy.

The concept of this bespoke YPT Workshop is to focus on the younger generation, stimulating discussion of a variety of aspects and the exchange of ideas regarding living organ donation, in the presence of senior faculty from the USA, Europe, and beyond. The workshop is aimed at junior transplant surgeons and physicians (aged <40 y) not holding a Consultant/Attending post yet. We have space for 30 participants, and you will find a preliminary version of the Workshop and Main Conference programme attached. Attendance at the workshop and subsequent larger meeting is free for those 30 YPTs selected from the applications.

To date, we have funding to support 20 participants of the 30 candidates selected from all applications with a **Travel Grant of €500** to compensate costs for travel and accommodation. Of note is that those awarded with a Travel Grant will be reimbursed only after the candidate has presented him/herself on site. For all 30 YPT participants, the congress agency will recommend nice and affordable accommodation in Murano.

Please, apply with a short motivation letter (max 1 A4) and a brief CV (max 2 A4), highlighting your interest and activities as a YPT in the field of donation and transplantation. Kindly send the application via email to ypt.murano.2026@gmail.com using the subject "LD Workshop 2026 in Murano". The deadline for applications is 15 February 2026. Priority will be given to applicants who have not attended previously.
